A large, high-ceiling room in the Tate Modern has been set aside for sculptures that are part of the Arte Povera movement that started in the late 1960s when artists across the world started exploring the process of making three-dimensional work and exploring the involvement of energy in their creation.

Arte povera means literally 'poor art' but the word poor here refers to the movement's signature exploration of a wide range of materials beyond the traditional ones of oil paint on canvas, bronze, or carved marble.Materials used by the artists included soil, rags and twigs. In using such throwaway materials they aimed to challenge and disrupt the values of the commercialised ...

Later returned to creating marble sculpture, using traditional carving techniques. Pino Pascali (1935-68) culptor, painter, graphic designer, influenced by Rauschenberg and Pop-Art, before becoming associated with Arte Povera. Known for his series of Fictitious Sculptures (1966), and his set of Water Pieces (1967). Died in a motorbike crash.
