Lift the transfer switch up to the wall where it is to be installed and label the placement of the mounting screws. The transfer switch should be placed roughly 1 1/2 feet (45.72 cm) away from the midpoint of the main circuit breaker. 12 Affix the transfer switch to the wall, using mounting screws.
