Only three countries boast a female majority in government. Rwanda tops the list, with women holding 61.4 percent of parliament seats, followed by Cuba (53.2 percent) and Bolivia (53.1 percent).

As of April 1, 2019, the global average of women in national assemblies is 24.3 percent. At the same time, large differences exist between countries, e.g. Sri Lanka has quite low female participation rates in parliament compared with Rwanda, Cuba, and Bolivia, where female representation rates are the highest.

## Both India and Pakistan saw record-breaking representation of female legislators in their last elections. In India, more than 700 women contested seats in the 2019 general elections, of which 78 (about 11 percent) secured seats —the highest number of victorious female candidates in the electoral history of India.
