the exemptions section in our guidance books will help you judge if your felling is exempt from the requirement to obtain a felling permission; if no exemptions apply, you must apply for a felling permission; if you are exempt, you can fell the trees. Always check by contacting your local Conservancy or a forestry professional if you are unsure. There are penalties, such as fines, for felling without a valid permission.

The DFO shall grant permission/NOC for the felling of trees by issuing a digitally signed NOC through the online portal within 3 days on uploading the inspection report and is communicated to the owner of the trees and the concerned FRO via SMS. 7. The applicant shall download the final

A felling licence granted by the Minister for Agriculture, Food and the Marine provides authority under the Forestry Act 2014 to fell or otherwise remove a tree or trees and to thin a forest for management reasons. The Forestry Act 2014 provides for a single licence process for tree felling: Making a tree felling licence application.

Land owners may for their bonafied domestic and agricultural use fell three trees of coniferous (except Chil trees) and in case of Chil and other trees five trees each year without permission and upto 10 trees with the writtn permission of the Range Officer concerned and more than 10 trees with written permission of the Divisional Forest Officer concerned.

A: Yes, To Control the indiscriminate felling of trees, the Government of Karnataka has enacted “The Karnataka Preservation of Trees Act, 1976”. This act has come in to force on 17th day of July, 1976.

Felling licences You normally need to get permission from the Forestry Commission to fell growing trees. They give this with a felling licence or with approval under a Dedication Scheme. In certain circumstances, you may also need permission from other organisations, such as your Local Authority, for any proposed felling.

Tree Felling - getting permission Introduction Getting permission from the Forestry Commission to fell trees In any calendar quarter*, you may fell up to 5 cubic metres on your property without a licence as long as no more than 2 cubic metres are sold. (*1 Jan to 31 March, 1 April to 30 June, 1 July to 30 September and 1 October to 31 December.)

Tree Felling getting permission - Madasafish

Certain types of felling do not need permission from the Forestry Commission. The Forestry Act 1967, as amended, and related regulations gives these exceptions in full. The main categories are...

Tree Felling - East Lindsey

Felling Where a tree must be felled, a felling licence may be needed. It is an offence for anyone to fell a tree, or treed area over 5 cubic metres, without one. There are exemptions where a licence is not needed, detailed on the Forestry Commission website.
